As per the United States Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF) recommendations and American Academy of Family Physicians (AAFP) guidelines for Adult Preventative Care, the following standard screenings (some of which require lab tests or imaging), are routinely conducted for all patients at LLCHC.

Alcohol screening

Breast cancer screening

Cervical cancer screening

Chlamydia and Gonorrhoea screening

Colorectal cancer screening

Depression screening

Diabetes mellitus screening

Drug screening

Hepatitis B virus infection screening

Hepatitis C virus infection screening

HIV infection screening

HIV prevention with PrEP

Hypertension screening

Lung cancer screening

Obesity/weight loss screening

Osteoporosis screening

Syphilis screening

Tobacco use and cessation screening

Tuberculosis screening

Fall prevention screening
